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Discussions around MC

- EPICUR mission statement:
- "Our European University for the future is a place where all our **boundlessly mobile students, doctoral candidates and staff** irrespective of their nationality, mother tongue, cultural or socioeconomic background, acquire a **broad, interdisciplinary, academic perspective** strongly rooted in our European traditions"
- MC have not been planned for the pilot phase
- MC increasingly at the centre of our strategical discussions to certify our learning offers in multilingualism & LAS, based on the blockchain technology

Certification of a "European study experience" done on various campuses with a digital certificate (platform)





European standard of MC would bring some solutions to existing issues

- More flexibility in the innovative EPICUR pedagogical offer:
 - Modular learning pathways: modules according to competencies
 - Flexibility in re to ECTS: from a couple of courses up to 30 ects
 - Flexibility in re to the mobility formats: F2F, hybrid, virtual
- Quality assurance: common pedagogical contract with learners with transparent criteria, comparable across borders
- Attractiveness of joining a coherent study programme aiming at a certificate once completed, instead of "just" 1 & 2 semesters abroad
